The Nature of God. The Bible says God is Holy, morally perfect and separate from creation. God says "be ye Holy, for I am Holy." God requires perfection in thought, word and deed. God is just and promises to judge righteously. God is all powerful, all knowing and unchangeable. You can't hide or pervert His righteous judgment. God "searches the heart" and promises to "render to every man according to his deeds." God is love and loves that which is good and hates evil. He shows mercy to "thousands that love Him and keep His commandments" but "He will by no means clear the guilty." The Nature of Man. Are you good? Look at the 10 commandments: Have you ever lied? "All liars have their part in the lake of fire." Have you ever lusted at someone? Jesus said this is the same as adultery. Have you ever hated without cause? Jesus said this is the same as murder. Have you ever used God's name in vain? God says "He will not hold him guiltless that takes His name in vain." The Bible says if you break "one commandment" you are guilty of all.
